Dear Mr. Welch and Mr. Comorre:

Environmental Intelligence, LLC (EI) has been retained by the City of Beverly Hills (COBH) and the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) to serve as the independent compliance monitor (ICM) during construction of the Purple Line Extension Project. Monitoring is required to ensure that construction is in compliance with (1) the Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) for Southern California Edison's (SCE's) Advance Utilities Relocation Phase of the Purple Line Extension Project -Segment 2 – Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 384-17), (2) the MOA for the Third Party Advance Utility Relocation Phase of the Purple Line Extension Project – Section 2 - Between the City of Beverly Hills and the Los Angeles Metropolitan Transportation Authority (City Agreement No. 648-17) and (3) the Agreement titled "Demolition and Public Right-of-Way Use Permit for the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority and its Contractor to Clear All Buildings and Existing Improvements at 9430 Wilshire Boulevard, Install Noise Monitoring Equipment and Sound Walls for Future Construction and a Laydown Area for the Wilshire/Rodeo Station of Section Two of the Purple Line Extension Project" (Agreement dated June 5th, 2018). The following information summarizes the ICM monitoring activities that occurred at the Segment 2 site (Rodeo Station site) during the week of October 21, 2018 – October 27, 2018. Construction activities were not conducted on October 21 or October 27.

Construction activities conducted during the week included demolition of the Ace Gallery with work focused on demolishing the north and west walls, roofing, and the canopy structure on the eastern face; upgrading scaffolding around the Ace Gallery perimeter; in addition to placing aesthetic screening on the fencing around Reeves Park. EI ICMs were present on site during all construction activities and conducted routine noise measurements at selected noise monitoring locations as well as compliance checks in accordance with the MOAs and associated attachments, exhibits, traffic closure notifications, and traffic management plans. At the conclusion of each work shift, daily monitoring reports were prepared by each ICM. Attachment B (*Daily Monitoring Report Summaries*) provides detailed daily monitoring reports and photographs of construction activities.

VIOLATION SUMMARY

During the week, EI ICMs identified one (1) violation during construction activities. Table I provides a summary of the violation identified during the week of October 21, 2018 – October 27, 2018 and Exhibit 1 (*Violation Location [October 21-27, 2018]*) provides a location map depicting the reported violation.

CONCLUSION

To date, 43 violations have been issued, 4 of which have been rescinded since the beginning of construction of the Purple Line Extension Project – Segment 2. Project construction activities are ongoing and EI ICMs continue to monitor all construction activities applicable to the MOA on a daily basis.




EXHIBIT 1 : VIOLATION LOCATION (OCTOBER 21 - OCTOBER 27, 2018)




